Role Requirements

- Demonstrable interest and commitment to children’s rights and access to justice
- Commitment to equality and diversity and with an inclusive approach.
- Demonstrable skills in strategic oversight, development and collective working
- Understanding and, where possible, experience of role as charity trustee
- Understanding of financial statements, budgets and accounts in line with governance responsibilities
- Knowledge and, where possible, experience of, current fundraising and finance practice relevant to charities
- Background in any of the following areas with a specific focus and/or interest in children and young people’s rights:
 - strategy and strategic planning
 - co-production
 - communications
 - service development and provision
 - finance, audit and risk
 - legal
 - fundraising
- Empathy with the vision, mission and aims of the centre
- Commitment to maintaining confidentiality on confidential and/or sensitive information
- Personal capacity for regular time commitment as a trustee, both in terms of board meetings and supporting the centre
- All Trustees must be eligible to act as a trustee under the current legislation in Scotland
